The Brower Youth Awards recognize six environmental leaders age 13-22 with prizes of \$3,000 each. Additionally, each winner is brought to San Francisco for the award week and a backcountry camping trip.

Outstanding middle and high school age volunteers are eligible to receive \$1,000 and an all-expense-paid trip with a parent or guardian to Washington, D.C. from Prudential.

NetAid honors high school students who have organized and led a project that has helped people in developing countries, or raised awareness about global poverty in their own communities. Honorees receive a \$5,000 scholarship.
